New rules for Five Pin Bowling

- 1. If you holler "overs!" before the ball passes the arrows, you get to throw the ball over, unless of course, you get a strike. In which case, you can renege on the "overs".*
- 2. When your team is down in the 8th or 9th frame, you can invoke the rule "First Team Through Bowling Wins the Game", and your team still has a chance.*
- 3. After a member of the opposing team bowls a turkey, he/she must bowl the next 3 frames blindfolded. If he/she continues to strike, his/her shoelaces will be tied together for 2 frames.*
