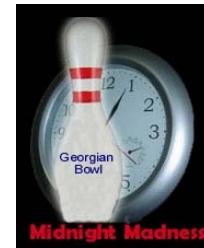

Holiday Classic

- ◆ Open to all registered bowlers 18 years of age or older as of December 31, 2009.
- ◆ Pins over Average format.
- ◆ No initial cost to the bowler.
- ◆ Must have bowled a minimum of 12 games by October 25th to qualify.
- ◆ League round must be completed between November 16 and December 8. Ask your league executive when it officially starts for your league.
- ◆ All members will bowl a one week league round during regular league play in an attempt to bowl over their average. Bowlers who wish to better their score may enter a second week for a cost of \$7. If time permits, they may enter a third and fourth week.
- ◆ The top five qualifiers will form team 1, the next five will form team 2 and so on. (There is a specific formula used to determine how many teams will move on to the next round.)
- ◆ Those bowlers who qualify for the next round will be notified and given the date and cost at that time.
