  - Pins over Average format
  - No initial cost to the bowler
  - Must have bowled a minimum of 12 games by October 11<sup>th</sup> to qualify
  - League rounds will start mid October, and will continue for four consecutive weeks, ask your league executive for the exact date
- Those bowlers who qualify for the next round will be notified and given the date and cost at that time.
